Richard and Sarah talk about “fast fashion” and the amount of resources wasted in the manufacture of clothes.

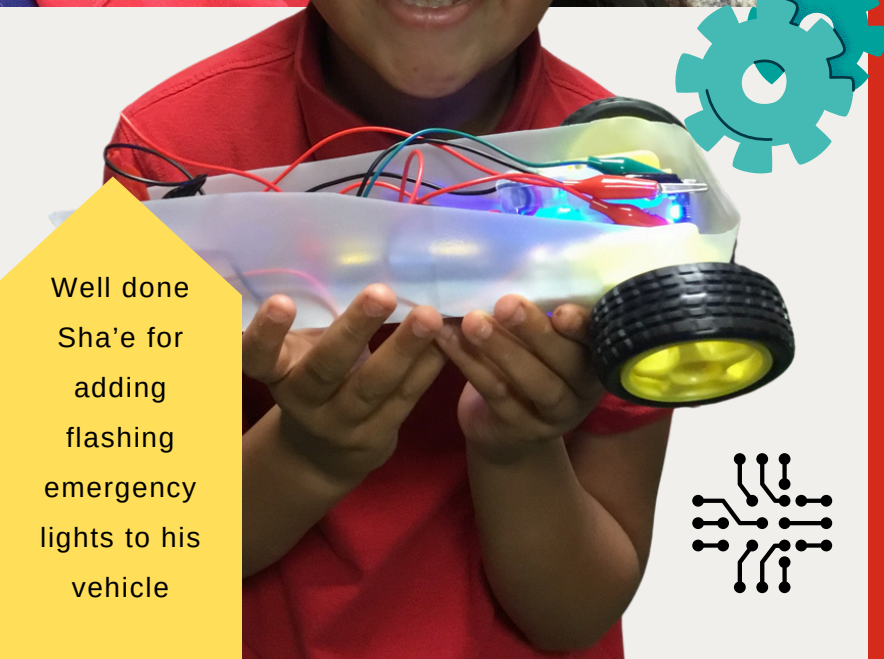

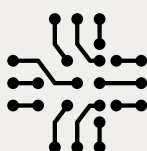
YEAR 6 CODERS
